The Mission of the Brunswick (Brittonkill) Central School District is to provide an education that fosters excellence, creativity, responsibility, citizenship, and lifelong learning.

Goal 1: Improve Student Achievement

Objective 1: Decrease the number of students at risk for academic failure by continuing to maintain the number of students enrolled in the district's RAPP and Pre-K programs.

Objective 2: Increase the percentage of students demonstrating proficiency at the new cut points in Math and ELA grade 3-8 and High School Regents exams

Objective 3: Increase the percentage of economically disadvantaged students demonstrating proficiency in Math and ELA grades 3-8 and High School Regents exams

Objective 4: Increase the percentage of students with disabilities demonstrating proficiency in Math and ELA grades 3-8 and High School Regents exams

Data used to determine if goals were met: NYS Report Card, 3-8 testing (sub-groups) Regents exams, graduation rates, and successful course completion rates

Goal 2: Demonstrate sound financial practices and operations management through effective, responsible decision-making.

Objective 1: Investigate at least one alternative funding source/cost saving measure

Objective 2 Continue to focus on school safety including review of security protocols (ie. Access, hours open, dissemination of security information)

Objective 3: Identify alternative ways of improving the allocation and use of limited resources, including staff

Objective 4: Monitor growth and development within the community
