Positions focus on Teaching and Learning (6)

- Two Elementary Teachers (Primary and Intermediate)
- Two Middle School Teachers
- Two High School Teachers

Primary Responsibilities

- ✚ Serve as a “knowledgeable and respected” colleague on teaching and learning
 - Serve as a direct resource and support to classroom teachers
 - Serve as a member of the school’s Instructional Support Team (IST)
 - Serve as a member of the district’s Teaching and Learning Support Team
- ✚ Provide leadership for reviewing and using student achievement and assessment results
- ✚ Help to plan, organize, conduct and evaluate staff development workshops and activities
 - Serve as a member of the Professional Development Plan committee
 - Support the planning, organizing, and evaluating of superintendent conference days or alternative approaches to district-wide staff orientation and training
- ✚ Assist in the recruitment and selection process for teachers, TA’s, and substitutes
- ✚ Participate in monitoring and sharing the latest research, major trends and best practices in teaching and learning
- ✚ Facilitate regular opportunities for professional discussions on K-12 instructional program delivery, pedagogy, student achievement and assessment results

Appointment

- ✚ Three-year term (Initial terms varied to provide for a smooth pattern of turnover over time)
- ✚ Selection will be made by the Superintendent, after consultation with an advisory group of faculty member (2 per school) selected by the school leadership team
