Medical Examination

New York State law requires that your child is required to have a medical examination before entering school.

School districts must require that students enrolled in public school have a satisfactory health examination conducted by their family physician, physician assistant or nurse practitioner, upon first entering their school at any grade level.- State Law (8 NYCRR § 136.3(b)(1))

To be acceptable, the examination must have been conducted no more than 12 months before the first day of the school year in question.- State Law (8 NYCRR § 136.3((b))

This can be done by your own physician or by the school nurse practitioner/school physician. If you wish to have your own physician to do your child's exam, please use the School Physical Exam Form. Have your doctor complete it and you will need to return it to the school nurse within 30 days of enrollment.
